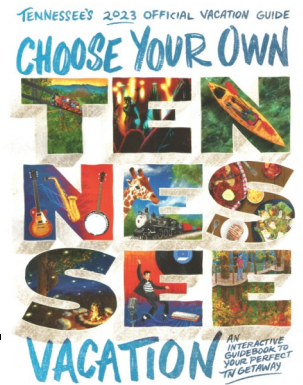

FREE ON-SITE DOCUMENT SHREDDING

Be better equipped to NOT be scammed! Identity theft resulting from items stolen from the trash is the easiest type of crime to prevent. Shred documents, receipts, address labels, or pieces of paper with info like account numbers regularly.

HOW IT WORKS

Upon entering the Amana Ave gate, follow the signs for the shred location. Place your bag of documents in your trunk. (All paper MUST be free of staples, paper clips, or any metal.) A volunteer will retrieve your shred items without you having to leave your car for a contactless disposal. As you leave, you'll receive a thank you Goody Bag filled with useful info and items to help keep you safe from scammers!
