In conjunction with the Annual Governor's Volunteer Stars awards, Tennessee's statewide volunteer recognition program, the Fayetteville Lincoln County Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau, serving as the Lincoln County Coordinator, has selected the Lincoln County Adult and Youth Honorees for 2023!

Each year the Governor's Volunteer Stars Awards recognizes volunteers who have displayed tremendous dedication to serving in various ways throughout their local Tennessee communities. Nominees were judged based on the community's need of the volunteer service performed, initiative taken to perform the service, creativity used to solve a community problem and impact of the volunteer service on the community. Recipients of the Lincoln County volunteer awards will not only be honored at an upcoming Lincoln County Commission meeting but will also receive a statewide award.



In the adult category, this year's honoree is **Tracy Holder.**

Tracy was selected based on her service to our community through her work with Leadership Lincoln and also her dedication to the American Cancer Society's Relay For Life since 2008. Tracy used her leadership skills to create and plan the Night of Hope Ball which has been an annual event since 2016.

Charlie Burk has been selected as the 2023 youth recipient for his heart for servant leadership in the field of health care; specifically his chosen project in the Ingram Scholars Program of seeing a need to research and evaluate mental health needs here locally and acting on it. The Ingram Scholar Program sponsors students who demonstrate a willingness and ability to combine a successful career with a lifelong commitment to developing solutions to critical societal problems.
